# 2021 AWARDS OF EXCELLENCE

The Tennessee Hospital Association (THA) has issued a call for nominations for its 2021 Awards of Excellence. Each year, the association conducts an awards program to honor individuals and organizations that have significantly contributed to the association or one of its institutional members. Awards to be presented this year:

- COVID-19 Healthcare Hero Award
- CEO of Distinction
- Senior Executive of Distinction
- Trustee of Distinction
- Nurse Leader of Distinction
- Clinical Nurse of Distinction
- Patient Safety Leadership
- Diversity Champion

Presentations will be made during the annual membership meeting, scheduled from Oct. 13 through Oct. 15, 2021, at the Franklin Marriott Cool Springs.

## CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

All nomination materials must be submitted via email to Vicki Wallace at [vwallace@tha.com](mailto:vwallace@tha.com). A nomination packet for each nominee should be compiled in a single PDF, including the nomination form, letters of recommendation and all other required documentation. Please do not send individual documents in separate emails. Letters must be signed and may be scanned if electronic signatures are not available.

The deadline to submit nominations is Friday, May 21. All nominations must be received by email on or before this date to be considered. Please follow nomination guidelines in each category. It is the responsibility of the hospital/health system to make all arrangements associated with ensuring the presence of the nominee at the awards presentation. The hospital/health system that nominated the award recipient is responsible for purchasing special event tickets for the award recipient, his/her family members and other guests, travel arrangements and hotel accommodations. THA does not pay for any of these expenses for award recipients.

## NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS AND GUIDELINES

Please read the criteria for each award. Documentation supporting nominations becomes the property of THA.

All nomination materials must be compiled and submitted in a single PDF document for each individual. They should be sent via email to Vicki Wallace at [vwallace@tha.com](mailto:vwallace@tha.com). The file name of the PDF should include both the nominated person's name and the title of the award (for example, "John Doe - CEO of Distinction Award.pdf"). Hospitals and health systems may submit up to five nominations for the entire awards program. Nomination packets should be completed before they are submitted. Do not send individual letters or other information to THA. Incomplete nominations may be deemed invalid.

All nominations must be submitted with the signature of the nominator – do not send it without a signature. If a CEO is nominating an individual for an award, he/she must sign the nomination form for it to be valid. Letters must be signed and may be scanned if electronic signatures are not available. THA reserves the right to move nominations into more appropriate categories. The awards committee reserves the right not to present an award in a category if no appropriate nominations are submitted.

Photographs must be submitted separately via email as a .JPEG file and must include the name of the individual and the name of the award in the file name. Please submit a high resolution JPEG photo suitable for publication.

*Only individuals submitting winning nominations will be notified in advance of the annual membership meeting.*

## COVID-19 HEALTHCARE HERO AWARD

Healthcare workers at Tennessee hospitals—at all levels in every department—have faced unprecedented challenges during the COVID-19 pandemic, far beyond anything they could have imagined.

During this healthcare crisis, many workers have demonstrated a level of caring and courage that have earned them the title of Healthcare Hero. They faced shortages of critical supplies and personnel, rapidly changing prevention and treatment protocols, families unable to be with their loved ones, physical and emotional exhaustion, an unbelievable death toll and the daily fear of the unknown.

THA knows hospitals across the state have seen many employees go above and beyond the call of duty when caring for COVID patients and their families. To honor one of these special hospital employees or group of employees, THA now is accepting nominations for a special 2021 COVID-19 Healthcare Hero Award.

This award will recognize an individual or group for exceptional service that went above and beyond normal duties while working with COVID patients or on behalf of COVID patients at a THA member hospital. Individuals eligible to be nominated for this award include nurses, physicians and any full-time employee that has worked at a THA member hospital for a minimum of two years, which must be documented in the nomination.

All nomination materials must be submitted via email to Vicki Wallace at [vwallace@tha.com](mailto:vwallace@tha.com). A nomination packet for each nominee should be compiled in a single PDF, including the nomination form, letters of recommendation and all other required documentation. Please do not send individual documents in separate emails. The file name of the PDF should include both the nominated person's name and the title of the award (for example, "John Doe – COVID-19 Healthcare Hero Award.pdf").

Submit via email in a single PDF document to [vwallace@tha.com](mailto:vwallace@tha.com):

- A detailed narrative (2 to 5 pages) citing contributions, achievements, etc. regarding COVID patients at their institution.
- A current curriculum vitae or narrative biography of the nominee in the case of an individual nomination or the group leader in the case of a group nomination.
- Two to three letters in support of the nomination. Letters may be signed and scanned if an electronic signature is not available.
- Completed nomination form.
- **A high resolution photograph of the nominee suitable for publication.** Photos must be sent separately from the nomination packet and be in a .JPEG format and must include the name of the individual and the name of the award in the file name.

## CEO OF DISTINCTION AWARD

The CEO of Distinction Award is the highest award presented by the association. It recognizes leadership and service by an individual member to THA during his or her entire career, not for a single act or contribution. It also recognizes achievements and contributions to the healthcare industry.

Nominees must be employed as a chief executive officer by an institutional member of the association for a minimum of eight years, which must be documented in the nomination (it does not have to be at the same institution). Include activities and achievements at the nominee's place of employment, professional organizations, community organizations and service to the association (participation on THA committees, councils, etc.).

Submit via email in a single PDF document to [vwallace@tha.com](mailto:vwallace@tha.com):

- A detailed narrative (2 to 5 pages) citing contributions, achievements, honors, etc., to THA, his/her institution and healthcare in Tennessee.
- A current curriculum vitae or narrative biography of the nominee.
- Two to three letters in support of the nomination, one of which must be from an individual not employed by or directly associated with the nominee's employer. One letter must be from the institution's board chairman. Letters may be signed and scanned if an electronic signature is not available.
- **A high resolution photograph of the nominee suitable for publication.** Photos must be sent separately from the nomination packet and be in a .JPEG format and must include the name of the individual and the name of the award in the file name.

## SENIOR EXECUTIVE OF DISTINCTION AWARD

The Senior Executive of Distinction Award recognizes leadership and service by individuals in support of THA member hospitals and health systems. Individuals in the c-suite are eligible for this award, including chief operating officers, assistant or associate administrators, vice presidents, chief nursing officers, chief medical officers, etc.

Nominees must be employed by a THA member hospital or health system for a minimum of four years (does not need to be at the same institution). This award recognizes individual contributions to the work of member institutions of THA or the association.

Submit via email in a single PDF document to [vwallace@tha.com](mailto:vwallace@tha.com):

- A detailed narrative (2 to 5 pages) describing why this individual deserves recognition, including contributions to the healthcare industry, employer, association, professional organizations and community.
- A current curriculum vitae or narrative biography of the nominee.
- Two to three letters in support of the nomination. One letter must be from the institution's CEO. Letters must be signed and may be scanned if electronic signatures are not available. Letters may be signed and scanned if an electronic signature is not available.
- **A high resolution photograph of the nominee suitable for publication.** Photos must be sent separately from the nomination packet and be in a .JPEG format and must include the name of the individual and the name of the award in the file name.

## TRUSTEE OF DISTINCTION AWARD

This award recognizes active or recently retired members of the board of directors or associate/advisory board of a THA member institution. They must have served as hospital or health system trustees for a minimum of four years.

- A detailed narrative (2 to 5 pages) describing why this individual deserves recognition, including contributions to the healthcare industry, employer, association, professional organizations and community.
- A current curriculum vitae or narrative biography of the nominee.
- Two to three letters supporting the nomination. One of the letters supporting the nomination should be from the institution's chief executive officer, and others may be from a board member colleague and/or from an officer or member of the medical staff.
- Letters must be signed and may be scanned if electronic signatures are not available.
- **A high resolution photograph of the nominee suitable for publication.** Photos must be sent separately from the nomination packet and be in a .JPEG format and must include the name of the individual and the name of the award in the file name.

## NURSE LEADER OF DISTINCTION AWARD

The Nurse Leader of Distinction Award recognizes outstanding contributions in nursing by a registered nurse employed at a THA member hospital or health system in the position of nursing director, manager, supervisor, clinical educator, case manager, nurse manager or leader responsible for quality initiatives and improved patient outcomes. Areas of achievement to be considered include quality improvement, innovative retention and recruitment proposals, cost reduction initiatives and leadership abilities.

Nominees must be employed by a THA member institution for a minimum of four years (does not need to be at the same institution).

Submit via email in a single PDF document to [vwallace@tha.com](mailto:vwallace@tha.com):

- A detailed narrative (2 to 5 pages) describing why this individual deserves recognition, including contributions to the healthcare industry, employer, association, professional organizations and community.
- A current curriculum vitae or narrative biography of the nominee.
- Two to three letters supporting the nomination. One letter must be from the institution's CEO. Letters must be signed and may be scanned if electronic signatures are not available.
- **A high resolution photograph of the nominee suitable for publication.** Photos must be sent separately from the nomination packet and be in a .JPEG format and must include the name of the individual and the name of the award in the file name.

## CLINICAL NURSE OF DISTINCTION AWARD

The Clinical Nurse of Distinction Award recognizes outstanding contributions to registered nurses who contribute directly at the point of care and/or bedside nursing at a THA member hospital or health system. Areas of achievement to be considered include outstanding/exemplary bedside patient care, role model for colleagues, mentor for new staff, serves as patient advocate, proactive in making recommendations and supportive of process improvements on behalf of improved outcomes for patients.

Nominees must be employed by a THA member institution for a minimum of four years (does not need to be at the same institution).

Submit via email in a single PDF document to [vwallace@tha.com](mailto:vwallace@tha.com):

- A detailed narrative (2 to 5 pages) describing why this individual deserves recognition, including contributions to the healthcare industry, employer, association, professional organizations and community.
- A current curriculum vitae or narrative biography of the nominee.
- Two to three letters supporting the nomination. One letter must be from the institution's CEO. Letters must be signed and may be scanned if electronic signatures are not available.
- **A high resolution photograph of the nominee suitable for publication.** Photos must be sent separately from the nomination packet and be in a .JPEG format and must include the name of the individual and the name of the award in the file name.

## PATIENT SAFETY LEADERSHIP AWARD

The Patient Safety Leadership Award recognizes an individual who has taken extraordinary and innovative steps to make patient safety and quality a top priority in their organization. It honors superior efforts in preventing adverse health events and measures improvement through the hospital's participation in the Tennessee Center for Patient Safety collaboratives.

Nominees must be employed by a THA member institution for a minimum of four years (does not need to be at the same institution).

Submit via email in a single PDF document to [vwallace@tha.com](mailto:vwallace@tha.com):

- A detailed narrative (2 to 5 pages) describing why this individual deserves recognition, including a description of specific quality and patient safety activities and projects this individual has led, implementation strategies and outcomes achieved. Data and graphs to demonstrate improvements obtained are encouraged and do not count against the narrative pages. Quality and patient safety activities may include activities with the Tennessee Center for Patient Safety, organizational culture changes to support safety, and other contributions to the healthcare industry, employer, association, professional organizations and community.
- A current curriculum vitae or narrative biography of the nominee.
- Two to three letters supporting the nomination. Letters may be signed and scanned if an electronic signature is not available.
- **A high resolution photograph of the nominee suitable for publication.** Photos must be sent separately from the nomination packet and be in a .JPEG format and must include the name of the individual and the name of the award in the file name.

## DIVERSITY CHAMPION AWARD

The Diversity Champion Award recognizes a leader who has made outstanding contributions in fostering leadership, workplace diversity and inclusion, and demonstrated his or her commitment to a diverse workforce. This individual also places an emphasis on culturally competent care and involvement in the diverse communities served by the organization.

Nominees must be employed by a THA member institution for a minimum of four years (does not need to be at the same institution).

Submit via email in a single PDF document to [vwallace@tha.com](mailto:vwallace@tha.com):

- A detailed narrative (2 to 5 pages) describing why this individual deserves special recognition, with an emphasis on his or her leadership in diversity activities at a THA member hospital or health system. Include information on efforts to encourage diversity in healthcare, attract and retain employees from diverse backgrounds, and create new diversity initiatives.
- A current curriculum vitae or narrative biography of the nominee.
- Two to three letters supporting the nomination. One of the letters should be from the institution's CEO. Letters may be signed and scanned if an electronic signature is not available.
- **A high resolution photograph of the nominee suitable for publication.** Photos must be sent separately from the nomination packet and be in a .JPEG format and must include the name of the individual and the name of the award in the file name.
